

## Pain Management:

Every day the pain associated with surgery is managed with general anesthesia. The pain or discomfort associated with healing from surgery is different and not every patient tolerates it the same way. Pain medication associated with discomfort during healing can be discussed but generally it is utilized on a case by case basis. Please keep in mind that a little discomfort is a reminder that we are healing and that moving about may not be good. Less movement will help produce a positive outcome.

## Nausea and Vomiting:

Moving about, even a car ride can contribute to vomiting when a pet has just undergone anesthesia. Also, too much activity at home not only stimulates vomiting, it can lead to unnecessary pain at an invasive surgical site, and the loss of fluids can lead to dehydration which also slows post-operative healing. Anti-nausea medication can reduce the likelihood of vomiting and in turn will help them get their appetite back and feel better sooner.
